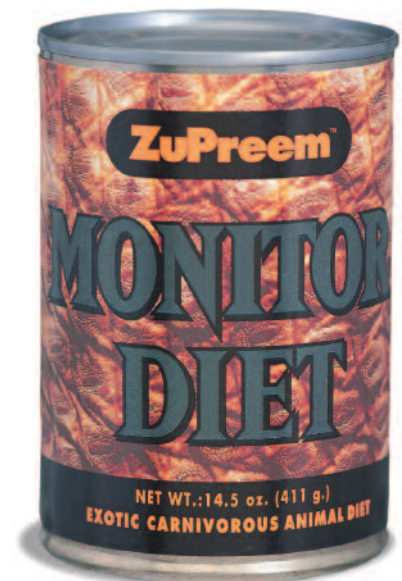

Feeding Instructions

Monitors and carnivorous lizards should be fed free choice every other day. If introduced at an early age, most monitors and other carnivorous lizards will thrive on ZuPreem® Monitor Diet Canned. Carnivorous reptiles accustomed to another diet will eat the ZuPreem diet if it is mixed with the existing diet. Over a course of seven to 14 days, gradually increase the amount of the ZuPreem diet until it makes up 100% of the total diet.

Many snakes will eat this diet especially if it is introduced at an early age. Do not starve a snake unwilling to eat the diet in the hopes that it will convert on its own. Smearing ZuPreem Monitor Diet canned on the animal's existing food such as mice or rats may encourage an easier conversion. Call and talk to one of our reptile specialists at ZuPreem if you have questions.

Feeding ZuPreem Monitor Diet Canned reduces transmission of ectoparasites and endoparasites resulting from feeding rodents, and eliminates physical trauma caused by potential rodent bites.

Replace with fresh canned diet if food becomes dried out. Cover and refrigerate unused food in can for up to five days. If refrigerated, return the diet to room temperature prior to feeding. Freshly opened product is always more palatable than older refrigerated product.

Do not feed to cattle or other ruminant animals.

Note – As an indicator of health, always check for changes in weight and body condition. Provide adequate amounts of food to maintain body condition, preventing excessive thinness or obesity.

Always provide clean, fresh water.

Water, Beef, Meat by-products, Liver, Chicken, Poultry by-products, Whole egg, Rice flour, Vegetable gum, Iron oxide, Choline chloride, Ferrous sulfate, Manganous oxide, Copper sulfate, Vitamin D₃ supplement, Vitamin E supplement, Thiamine, Niacin, Calcium pantothenate, Pyridoxine hydrochloride, Riboflavin, Folic acid, Biotin, Vitamin B₁₂ supplement.
